

# How to Connect an iPhone or iPad to the UNT Wi-Fi Network

These instructions apply to all modern iOS and iPadOS versions (iOS 15, 16, 17+). Menu names may vary slightly, but the process is the same.

---

## 1. Open Wi-Fi Settings

- Open the **Settings** app.
  - Tap **Wi-Fi**.
  - Ensure the Wi-Fi toggle is switched **On**.
- 

## 2. Select the “UNT” Network

Under *Networks*, tap **UNT**.

---

## 3. Enter UNT Credentials

When prompted, enter:

- **Username:** Your **UNT EUID**
- **Password:** Your **UNT EUID Password**

Tap **Join**.

If iPhone/iPad displays a **certificate trust** prompt:

- Review the certificate
  - Tap **Trust** in the upper-right corner
-

## 4. Connect

Your device will authenticate and complete WPA2/WPA3-Enterprise login. Once connected, a blue checkmark will appear beside **UNT**.

---

## 5. Verify You're Connected

Look for:

- A **checkmark** next to **UNT** in Wi-Fi settings
  - The **Wi-Fi icon** in the status bar
- 

## 6. If You Cannot Connect: Forget the Network and Try Again

If the device refuses your password, keeps prompting, or won't join the network, resetting the saved configuration usually fixes it.

### Forget the UNT Network

- Open **Settings** → **Wi-Fi**
- Tap the ⓘ (**info**) icon next to **UNT**
- Tap **Forget This Network**
- Tap **Forget** to confirm

### Restart the Login Process

- Turn **Wi-Fi Off**, then **On**
- Tap **UNT** again
- Re-enter your:
  1. **EUID username**
  2. **EUID password**
- Tap **Join**, and **Trust** the certificate if prompted

This clears cached credentials and usually resolves authentication issues.
